ACCOUNTABILITIES:

Establish and maintain positive relationships with referred students, parents, collaterals and school staff. Act as a liaison between special education department, classroom teacher and local district.

Offer teacher consultations for questions related to the special ed process, strategies, interventions etc.

- Develops Student Accommodation Plans for students and works with families and teachers for implementation, monitoring and tracking progress
- Plans, organizes, and assigns activities that are specific to each student's abilities
- Teaches and mentors students as a class, in small groups, and one-on-one
- Updates Student Accommodation Plans on predetermined interval schedule the school year to reflect students' progress and goals
- Discusses student's progress with parents, teachers, administrators, and relevant professionals within and outside of school related to the student's case
- Works with school district in meetings, for referral, planning, reviewing assessments and plans in addition to coordinating observations, evaluations etc.

Education: Bachelor's degree required with major study in Education or a closely related field.

Experience: Teaching experience with elementary aged students.
