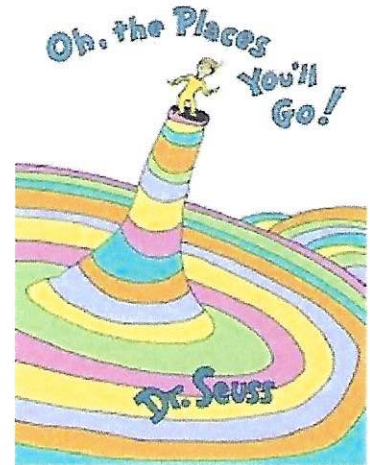
**Please also find the supply list for next year, in case you are out shopping those back to school sales that seem to start in July.**

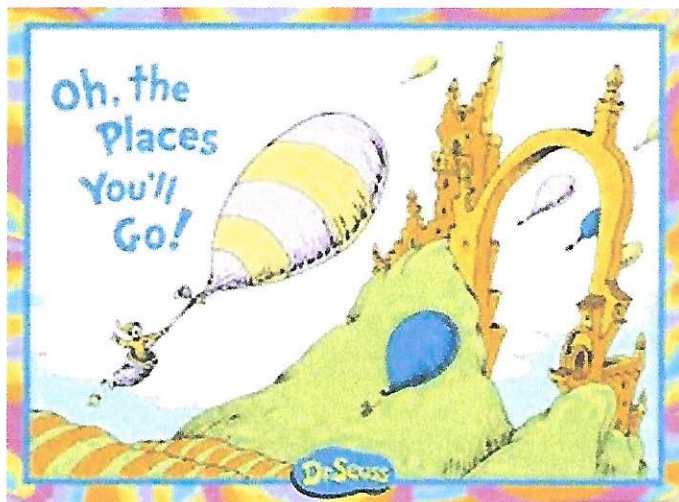
Dear Friend,
