Dear Sixth Grade Families,

Welcome to sixth grade! I am so glad to have your child in my class this year. As leaders of this school, we will build skills and strategies that will serve well into middle school and beyond. I am so fortunate to have gotten to work with them this past year. I have personally enjoyed getting to know each one of their writing voices. I love our group of spirited and creative thinkers!

Some things to know about me are that *I enjoy hands-on projects, experiments and learning through a variety of activities*. However, I am old-fashioned in that I value the connection between the brain and pencil in written work. We read and write much in this class. We also take notes and learn the value of revision and organization. I build foundations by breaking them down into manageable parts; reviewing is part of that process. Also, <u>I love teaching sixth grade</u>. I was blessed with a teacher who made it my favorite grade. I hope I can make it yours as well.

## Here are **some** highlights:

<u>Language Arts</u>: We will review foundations of grammar, vocabulary and spelling to formulate the basis for written work. Upon this, we will create a *Writing Portfolio* that includes a variety of writing styles from narrative to persuasive, research-based essays. Paraphrasing will be a focus as we learn proper citation.

We will be reading novels this year with an eye on deeper moral connections and symbolism that underlie the text. Greater attention will be given to making inferences. As we do this, we reflect upon Scripture in connection to each story.

Book reports are written but presented in a variety of ways. These are *very popular* favorites that include making slideshows, websites, newspapers, models and even movies!

Science: This year science will have a <u>new look!</u> In addition to Mrs. Merryfield's Natural Science class, Mrs. Monique Niemaszyk will be teaching the other science disciplines on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week. She will also be managing our Science Fair projects. Science will be taught using hands-on and project-based learning. All academic evaluations will be done in class. There will be no homework as grading will be done on daily comprehension of concepts learned in class. Student science fair projects will also be done in-house with a fair in the spring. Mrs. Niemaszyk has a Bachelor of Science degree and over 30 years of teaching experience in science.

<u>Math</u>: Our math topics will include numbers and operations, geometry and measurement, statistics, data analysis and probability, and problem solving with algebraic and logical reasoning. We will take these topics and *reinforce them with practice*. Please practice math facts over the summer (especially multiplication tables).

<u>Social Studies</u>: We will take a *world view of history* from ancient civilizations to the Greeks, Romans and Early Church. We will explore kingdoms from Medieval Europe to the shores of the Americas. This all begins with geography and culminates with a World Food Festival.

Religion: We will come to know God's love through studying his Word in Holy Scripture and prayer. We will learn about the promises and covenants of the Old and New Testaments. We write to seminarians and have welcomed them to our classroom. We have had many guests from the Daughters of Mary of Healing Love to a Carmelite who met St. Teresa of Calcutta. We study the saints and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. We are already prayer warriors and intercessors and will continue to grow with our "daily decade" of the Rosary. We also take Scripture to memory so it becomes alive and part of our being. Our first will be John 1:1.


