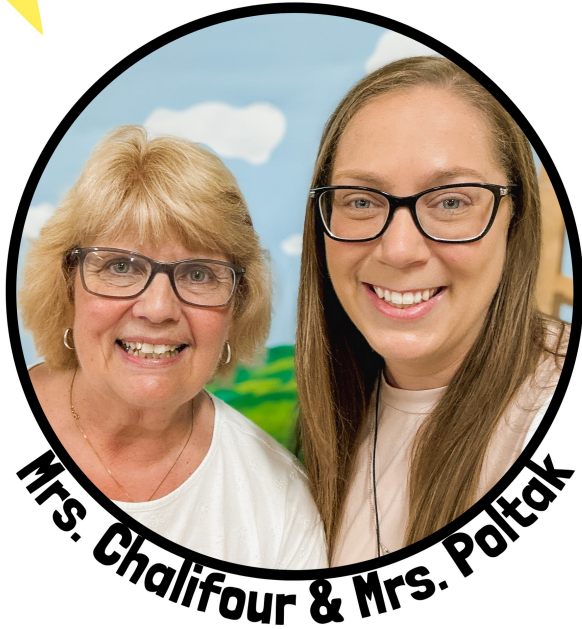


# Welcome to Kindergarten!
