

Boys Uniform

Students at St. Francis School wear 1 of 3 different uniforms: Gym on gym days, Regular on most days and Dress on Mass days. **Parents, as first educators, are expected to support the uniform and grooming policies set forth by St. Francis School.** Since neatness and good grooming speak refinement, we ask all parents to see that uniform regulations are kept. At the elementary level, it is the parent's responsibility to make sure that their child is in uniform before dropping them off. Students in Grades 2-6 will receive a Uniform Notice if they are out of dress code; multiple notices will result in parent conference.

Regular Uniform for PS – 6th Grade Boys

Warm Weather

• Shorts: Khaki shorts

Regular Uniform (Acceptable Any Season)

- Shirt: Navy Logo-ed Polo (short or long-sleeved)
- Pants: Khaki Slacks (Chino or docker style)
- Plain belt. PS-Grade 1 are exempt from wearing a belt.
- Socks: Navy, Khaki or white socks, leggings are never permitted.
- Sneakers or Shoes: Non-scuffing (No light-up, noise making shoes, boots, clogs, crocs, or flip flops permitted)
- School logo crew neck sweatshirt in gray, navy or burgundy. School polo must be worn under sweatshirt. Hooded options may not be worn inside with regular uniform. No full zipper up sweatshirts may be worn indoors.
- School logo sweater or fleece in burgundy or navy. Fleece can be full zip or 3/4 zip but not hooded. If you do not buy from Lands' End it MUST be correct in color. A logoed school polo must be worn under sweater or fleece.

Dress Uniform for PS – 6th Grade Boys

- Shirt: Button-down, oxford, solid white uniform shirt
- Tie: classic navy plaid from Lands' End

- Pants: Khaki Slacks (Chino or docker style with no side pockets and no elastic cuffs) sorry **no shorts** children will be able to take their vest off for recess if weather is warm.
- Vest: Burgundy sweater vest with school logo must be worn to Church. If weather is hot, we will instruct children to remove them for recess.
- Plain belt. PS-Grade 1 are exempt from wearing a belt.
- Socks: Navy, Khaki, or white socks
- Shoes: Non-scuffing navy, brown or black polishable leather-type dress shoe. Children in Grades PS K may wear navy, brown, or black sneaker in place of dress shoe.

Gym Uniform for PS – 6th Grade

Warm Weather Gym (April 1st – October 31st)

- Tee Shirt: School Logo Tee shirt, Walkathon Tee Shirt, or plain gray tee shirt with no non-school emblems
- Shorts: school uniform burgundy shorts (Lands' End) or plain burgundy shorts or plain gray shorts
- Socks: Navy, Khaki, or white socks
- Sneakers: no light up or distracting sneakers

All Weather Gym (Acceptable Any Season)

- Crew or hooded sweatshirts either plain or with logo (Lands' End) in gray, navy, or burgundy. This is the only day when a child can wear a hooded sweatshirt.
- Sweatpants either plain or with logo (Lands' End) in gray, navy, or burgundy.
- Tee Shirt: School logo t-shirt (long or short sleeved) must be worn under the outerwear at all times (Walkathon and field day shirts acceptable)
- Socks: Navy, Khaki or white socks
- Sneakers: no light up or distracting sneakers

NOTES

- Please note that boys will be "dress coded" for not having dress shoes, a belt, and a tie.
- Uniform logo-ed polos can be purchased from Lands' End (WWW.LANDENDS.COM # 900136813) OR polos can be purchased without the logo and then brought to <u>Silver</u> Graphics in Manchester to be embroidered (no iron-on)
- On Regular and Dress Uniform days, any outer wear worn during the day such as approved sweaters or sweatshirts must have a school logo.

BOYS GROOMING

Hair

- Neat and above collar length, no mohawks, no undercuts, no dyes, or otherwise distracting haircuts.
- As a rule: hair must be combed and not floppy or in eyes.
- Unnatural coloring or bleaching is strictly prohibited

Accessories

- Cosmetics, colored lip gloss/chapstick or artificial and painted nails are prohibited.
- Visible tattoos permanent or temporary are prohibited
- Piercing not allowed
- Jewelry limited to one watch (non-beeping, no internet) and a simple cross or holy medal on a silver or gold chain
- No Smart Watches (w/o permission) / No Cell Phones / No internet devices of any kind

Dress Down Day Guidelines

When permission is given for a Dress Down Day, clothing may be casual but must be appropriate for school.

Students may not wear:

- Flip flop sandals or crocs
- Open back shoes
- Tank tops
- Shirts or sweatshirts with inappropriate writing or pictures
- Shoes that convert to roller skates
- Biker shorts
- Pajamas
- Clothing that is extremely tight
- Skinny jeans, jeggings, or low-rise jeans. (Only traditional cut jeans may be worn.)

Good Rule: If you think you shouldn't wear it, you shouldn't.
